A \$4.5 million re-creation of historic Bourbon Street in New Orleans will be built in the Lucaya area of Freeport, Grand Bahama.

The reconstruction will be a perfect companion to the world-famous International Bazaar in Freeport which features shops selling luxury goods from around the world.

The project has been planned by the Grand Bahama Development Company, a subsidiary of the Port Authority which runs this tax-free community. Construction tenders are now being accepted.

The Bourbon Street replica will feature a variety of New Orleans-style restaurants, shops, a twin cinema and a bandstand for jazz performances.

Within walking distance of the new Monte Carlo casino which is expected to open this December, Freeport's Bourbon Street will add a new dimension to resort activities here.
